MATERIALS

½ yd of PA-301 ¼ yd of PA-201 ½ yd of PA-307 ½ yd of muslin Fiberfill stuffing

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Cut 2 (two) $8\frac{1}{2}$ "×14\%" rectangles of fabric A

Cut 2 (two) 81/2"×141/2" rectangles of fabric C

Cut 1 (one) $2\frac{1}{2}$ "×12" strip of fabric B

Cut 2 (two) 21/2"×16" strips of fabric B


Cut 2 (two) 161/2"×141/2" rectangles of muslin

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1. Make front & back units


- Grab one fabric A and one fabric C rectangles. Piece them together on the 14½" side, with a ¼" seam allowance. Press open.
- Repeat with the remaining fabric A and fabric C rectangles.
- MAKE CURVED EDGES
- Lay one of the units on a flat surface, WRONG side up.
- Mark with a dot the center of both long sides, measure and mark 11/4" down/up.
- Connect the corners with the middle dot with a curved line. (DIAGRAM 1)
- Cut through the line and repeat with remaining unit.

Step 2. Make decorative bands

- Using the 2½"×12" fabric B strip, fold it in half lengthwise, matching right sides together. Sew along the length using a ¼" seam allowance. (DIAGRAM 2)
- Use a turning tool to turn the piece right side out.
 Use the turning tool directions provided by the manufacturer for the basic turning steps and quidelines.
- Press the piece with the new seam line centered on the back. (DIAGRAM 3)
- Repeat this process with the 2 remaining fabric B strips.



Step 3. Apply band to the back

 Grab one of the units created on step 1, lay it flat RIGHT side up. Center the 1"×12" fabric B tube/band on top (seam facing down). Pin in place and take it to the sewing machine.


• Stitch with a 1/4" seam allowance on the curved top and bottom edges, making sure seams are centered and matching.

(DIAGRAM 4)


Step 4. Apply decorative chain band to the front

 Grab the remaining pillow body unit created on step 1, and make the following marks on the middle seam (on the RIGHT side), as they will serve as a guide to sew the band.



Grab one 1"×16" tube/band and make the following marks (on the seam side)


middle seam



- Try to center the marks (matching RIGHT side of the front unit & SEAM side of the band). Pin in place aligning the dots.
- Sew with a ½" seam allowance at the beginning and end of the strip (to secure ends).
 Now, sew on each mark across the width of the band, creating 5 loops.
 Remove pins as you stitch.


Step 5. Make rings

- Grab the remaining 1"×16" fabric B tube, cut it into 4 pieces, each 4" long.
- Wrap each of the tube/band pieces on the intersection of the loops. Make sure the seam of the tube is facing out. Sew both short ends with a 1/4" seam allowance. (DIAGRAM 8)
- Turn the rings inside out to hide the seams. (DIAGRAM 9)



Step 6. Make pillow

- Grab both body pillow units (front and back). Place one on top of the other, RIGHT sides together.
- Sew all the way around, starting from one of the sides, and leaving a 4" opening to insert the pillow form.
 (DIAGRAM 10)



Step 7. Make pillow form

- Using the muslin rectangles, follow the instructions to make the **CURVED EDGES** on step 1.
- Sew all the way around, starting from one of the sides, and leaving a 3" opening to insert the fiberfill stuffing.
- Insert the pillow form into the pillow body, and close by hand.
